## SANTA CRUZ COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE

The Santa Cruz County Department of Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services has launched a redesigned parks website featuring an improved and mobile-friendly user interface, interactive maps, dynamic events and programs calendars, and a COVID-19 updates page to keep the public informed about parks, coastal access, facilities and programs.

The pandemic has put an emphasis on the importance of parks and open space for our community's individual and collective health, and visitation to open spaces everywhere has increased. The new design incorporates several dynamic changes that make it easier to utilize County parks and programs, including a redesigned Permits & Reservations system, a revamped Aquatics section and visual and navigational improvements.
