## DRAFT CEMEX RESTORATION AND REUSE PLAN RELEASED

The Draft Restoration and Reuse Plan for the former Davenport Cement Plant site has been released for public review. The Draft Plan was prepared by RRM Design Group under contract to the County of Santa Cruz.
