Adopt a Kitten or Cat for only \$25 and "Pay it Forward" to Our Community's Neediest Animals!

The Santa Cruz County Animal Shelter (SCCAS) continues to experience an overload of cats and kittens so it is offering an autumn "Pay it Forward" special to help find homes for local animals and fund important community programs and services. Starting September 29, 2018 the adoption price for all cats and kittens is only \$25 through October 31, 2018!

SCCAS is also asking the community to "Pay it Forward" to their community's needlest animals by also donating at least \$25 to one of the following funds:

- Planned Pethood Fund, which funds FREE spay/neuter surgeries.
- Extra Mile Fund, which allows medical rehabilitation for animals beyond what our shelter budget permits.
- Healthy Pets for All Fund, which purchases pet food, pet toys, flea medication and other supplies for underserved animals in the community.
- **General Program Donation Fund**, which supports animal adoption, animal enrichment and public outreach and education programs.

The adoption fee includes spay/neuter, microchip (including registration), age appropriate vaccinations, routine treatment for fleas/worms, cat carrier and a free pet wellness exam with local participating veterinarians.

SCCAS currently has many beautiful cats and kittens waiting for a forever home. Open your heart and home by adopting a companion animal for a \$25 adoption fee and a generous donation that will help the local homeless and underserved animals in your community.
