Ryan Coonerty: Ryan Coonerty is a Supervisor for Santa Cruz County and a two-time former Mayor of the City of Santa Cruz. In 2008, he cofounded NextSpace Coworking + Innovation. He is also a lecturer on law and government at UC Santa Cruz. Coonerty is the co-author of The Rise of the Naked Economy – How to Benefit from the Changing Workplace (Macmillan, 2013) which was praised by economist Richard Florida for "capturing the tremendous challenges and opportunities for the Creative Class as they redefine work. This is a must read for anyone trying to figure how individuals, organizations, and communities prosper in the new economy." Coonerty also wrote Etched in Stone – Enduring Words from our National Monuments (National Geographic, 2007). He was selected by the Aspen Institute to be a Rodel Fellow in Public Leadership as one of "the nation's most promising young elected officials." Coonerty attended Santa Cruz's public schools and graduated from the University of Oregon's Clark Honors College. He received a master's degree from the London School of Economics and a law degree from the University of Virginia School of Law.
