





Portions of S.26, T10S, R3W, MDBM Portions of Davenport 7.5' USGS Quad Map

NOTICE OF INTENT TO HARVEST TIMBER / DOMESTIC WATER SUPPLY INQUIRY

A Timber Harvesting Plan (THP) will soon be submitted to CAL FIRE. We are remailing this notice out to include a statement on the NOI form 'that the approximate property lines have been flagged for review where truck roads, tractor roads, and/or harvest areas are within 100 feet of the property boundaries.' The Timberland Owner is Soper Company. The Plan Submitter is Soper-Wheeler Company, LLC. The RPF who prepared the THP is Heather Morrison, RPF# 2681. Location of the proposed timber operations: portions of Section 26, T10S, R3W, MDB&M, Santa Cruz County. The project is located approximately 0.25 miles southwest of the community of Bonny Doon. West Liddell Creek and its tributaries flow through the THP and property boundary. Approximately 70 acres are proposed for harvest. The silviculture method to be used is Selection, per 14 CCR 913.8 (a) and 14 CCR 928.7. The approximate property lines have been flagged for review where truck roads, tractor roads, and/or harvest areas are within 100 feet of the property boundaries.
