Geologic Report Required

If the geologic clearance for your project has determined that a geology report is required, you will be required to submit a geologic report for review and approval prior to submission of your building permit application.

However, you may choose to opt-out of preparing a geologic report for your project under certain conditions. You have the option to not prepare a geologic report if you decide to use the "CZU Rebuild Directive" approved by the County Board of Supervisors. Please click here for more information regarding the Directive.

Please note that whatever path is chosen, the building code requires that a geotechnical (soils) report to be submitted with your building permit application.
