

Geologic Report Required

If the geologic clearance for your project has determined that a geology report is required, you will be required to submit a geologic report for review and approval prior to submission of your building permit application.

However, you may choose to opt-out of preparing a geologic report for your project under certain conditions. You have the option to not prepare a geologic report if you decide to use the "CZU Rebuild Directive" approved by the County Board of Supervisors. Please note that whatever path is chosen, the building code requires that a geotechnical (soils) report to be submitted with your building permit application.
