    Projects in progress: County Medical Surge Preparedness, Mass Casualty Incident Preparedness, and Active Shooter Bag for Health Services Agency/EMS; Personal Body Armor for Santa Cruz PD; Portable Bollards for Capitola; Personal Body Armor for Watsonville PD; Mobile radios for multiple fire agencies; and Mobile Medical Shelter Coordination for County EMS.

New final application package was submitted on 1.28.2021 to align with 4 new National Priority Investment Justifications required by DHS/FEMA. Final approval now granted; award letters to be sent by 11.3.21.
  - 9.4.4 FY 2021 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) (2.75-year grant through 5.31.2024) award of \$341,759. Projects submitted in the Advance Application 4.21.2021 were updated to meet the 4 DHS/FEMA requirements addressing urgent national priorities for FY20 plus one new one for FY21. CalOES has reviewed and provided initial approval; awaiting further State and FEMA review. Complete application due 12.31.21.
