


The Edit tool will allow you to make adjustments to the boundary if needed, then when you are happy click the submit button to complete the form and mapping.



- Electoral datasets (Voter Registration and Statement of Vote) on 2020 Census Blocks
- Citizen Voting Age Population tabulations on 2020 Census Block geography






