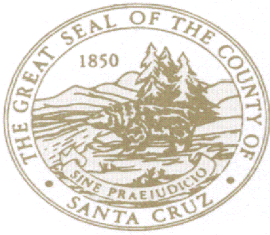

The purpose of the Santa Cruz County Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission is to inquire into the administration of juvenile court law in the County, and to coordinate on a county-wide basis the work of those governmental and non-governmental organizations engaged in activities designed to prevent juvenile delinquency.
