



If you changed your Health Plan for 2026...



- Your 2026 Health Plan change is now reflected in CalPERS under your 'myCalPERS' account at <https://my.calpers.ca.gov>
- Health Plans have started to mail your new insurance cards.
- Your new health plan rates will be reflected on your 12/12/2025 pay period 25 earnings statement (paycheck).

Your Doctor and Medical Group



- Health Plans are continuing to mail Welcome Letters listing your Medical Group and Doctor.
- New insurance cards will be issued to enrollees in Anthem Blue Cross HMO, UnitedHealthcare HMO, PERS Gold PPO, and PERS Platinum PPO to reflect CVS Caremark as your new Pharmacy Service.
- If you receive an insurance card that incorrectly assigned you to a Medical Group and/or Doctor, call your [Health Plan](#) to make the correction.

Be Proactive!



- Review your pay period 25 earnings statement dated 12/12/2025 to ensure your Plan Year 2026 Open Enrollment transactions for health, dental, and vision are correctly reflected.
- Review your pay period 1 (2026) earnings statement dated 01/09/2026 to ensure your Plan Year 2026 Open Enrollment transactions for D-Care and Flexible Spending Account (FSA) are correctly reflected.
- Beneficiary designations are vital to ensuring your wishes are fulfilled in the event of death. Updating your beneficiary can be done at any time, but now is the perfect time to review your Beneficiary Form(s) for the following applicable benefits: Basic Life Insurance, Supplemental Life Insurance, Deferred Compensation, PORAC, CalPERS.
