


1. Simpkins Swim Center & Live Oak Library Annex

- Swimming pool closed until June 2022
- December 7th the Board approved the plans for the Live Oak Library Annex at the Simpkins Family Swim Center and scheduled the project to be put out to bid.
- Community room will close at the end of the January for 18 months
- Artist will be selected to create a site-specific public art component for the new Library Annex - applications due January 21




2. Rail Trail Segments 10 & 11



2. Rail Trail Segments 10 & 11

- Segment 10 - 17th Ave to Jade St Park
- Segment 11 - Monterey Av to State Park Dr
- Scoping Meeting Completed Nov 17, 2021
- Draft EIR Spring 2022, Final EIR Summer 2022
- Both Rail next to Trail and Interim Trail are being evaluated
- City of Santa Cruz managing EIR for Segments 8&9, RTC managing EIR for Segment 12



3. Brommer Park

- Encampment cleared under no-trespassing laws
- 50 cu yards of debris removed from County Property, working on a solution to clear private property
- Thanks to Ron Perrigo of the Clean Team and new Live Oak Community Resources Officer Sgt. Randall Hop & Lt. Baldrige of Community Policing
- Signage and fencing in progress




4. Kaiser - 5940 Soquel Ave

- Uncertainty and delay caused by Watsonville Hospital Bankruptcy
- Final EIR and Planning Commission Review pushed from January to later in the Spring of 2022
- Investigating new state rezoning requirements
- Traffic impact mitigation projects requested include:
 - Sidewalk on Soquel Ave between Mattison Ln and Gross Rd
 - Signalization at S. Rodeo Gulch (reviewing warrants)



5. Highway 1 Auxiliary Lanes & Bike/Ped Bridge

- Project anticipated to start construction Summer 2022



6. Pure Water Soquel

- Ground breaking Dec. 2021. Project completion expected 2023.
- Secondary treated water pumped from nearby lagoon treatment plant to Chanticleer location for tertiary treatment.
- Tertiary treated water pumped to acquire injection wells in Soquel
- Educational facilities will be on-site



Artist's Rendering - Corner of Chanticleer and Soquel View




7. Mattison Ln Sewer Main Replacement

1. Obtain environmental clearances and permits - March 2022
2. Complete plans, specifications, engineer's estimates - May 2022
3. Obtain land rights - May 2022
4. Obtain financing - June 2022
5. Bid Projects - May 2022
6. Construct Projects - Begin June 2022, Completed October 2023
7. **Project Acceptance, moratorium evaluation End of 2023**
