<b>Measurement</b>			
This objective uses quarterly data to measure the % of Dislocated Workers who exit services who are employed 6 month after leaving the program.			
<b>Collection Method</b>			
Human Services collectes Dislocated Worker program data and wage information from EDD to track employment data. Since this metric is looking at 6-Month post exit employment, and wage data to determine employment does not become available for 3-6 months later, a 'rolling time period. is used. For example, the Reporting period of this metric is FY21-23 (Jul 2021 – Jun 2023), biut this covers exits in the range of Jul 2020 – Jun 2022, Q2 Post-Exit Employment from Jan 2021 – Dec 2022, with data availability from approx Sep 2021 to Jun 2023 (the final quarter of this metric is not yet available as of 5/24/23).
