

Q2 How confident do you feel in leading your team?



Q3 How often are you providing consistent team supervision?




Q4 How confident do you feel providing individual feedback to your team members?


Q5 How confident do you feel in providing consistent and equitable remote supervision to your team?

Q6 Do you feel you have the support/trust of your team?



Q7 Do you feel you have the support/trust of your supervisor?






