As climate change continues to affect the environment, efforts to both reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) and prepare for the impacts of climate change are ongoing in Santa Cruz County.

At the meeting, a representative of Quit Carbon will provide a presentation on services available to support homeowners to upgrade their homes' energy efficiency and reduce GHG emissions from home energy use.

Staff from the Community Development and Infrastructure department will provide an update on efforts to prepare for the impacts of climate change by implementing strategies to achieve the objective of becoming a more resilient community. These efforts include community engagement, interagency partnerships and funding mechanisms to study how climate change will impact the community and develop land use policy and regulatory updates to reduce risks and cost to public and private infrastructure in the future.
