DISASTER RECOVERY CENTERS TO BE EXTENDED

Beginning Thursday, February 16, Disaster Recovery Centers (DRCs) in Watsonville and Felton will be extended to continue providing recovery services to residents impacted by the Dec.-Jan. atmospheric rivers that impacted Santa Cruz County.

Staff from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and U.S. Small Business Administration will continue to be available for in-person assistance for residents and businesses to ask questions, register, or follow up on assistance related the event. President Biden has authorized a major disaster declaration for the storms, freeing up funding for community recovery.
