EVACUATION ORDERS LIFTED **Release Date** January 6, 2023 12:30PM

The evacuation order for the potential river flooding and tidal surge areas has been lifted by the Sheriff's Office. Residents may now return to the following zones:

CTL- 050, 051

Those returning to their homes should be mindful that conditions could change and slides are still possible due to soil saturation levels. Furthermore, Public works is still clearing roads of debris and sand, so take caution when driving in those areas.

As a reminder to the public, please be respectful of those whose homes were directly impacted by the flood and storm surge as they will need time to recover. These areas should be accessed by residents only as they begin the recovery process.

The safety of the community is of the utmost importance to the Sheriff's Office, and we appreciate your cooperation during this potentially dangerous weather system.
